Our Conviction

Our Aim

Our Area

Principally in the north Carlisle area, but we aim to use 10% of our income to support similar ministries elsewhere.

Our Methods

These are the main ways we use the money we receive:

- Training for Christian ministry
 - Making grants to individuals
- Employing people for Christian ministry
 - Helping to finance this through churches or other Christian bodies
 - Directly to fulfil our aims, especially where the role is wider than a single church would be able to support

Our Income

We rely on the generosity of individuals and other bodies who want to see our aims fulfilled. We do not spend income campaigning to raise more income. We do not want people to divert their giving away from support for their church.

Our Spending

The trustees meet regularly. They assess our finances and the known needs and then seek to use the money wisely and without holding onto excessive reserves. We have clear criteria in our grant making and employment policies to ensure we stick to our aims.
